Mezzo-soprano **Sasha Cooke** recently caused a sensation as Kitty Oppenheimer in the Metropolitan Opera premiere of John Adam's *Doctor Atomic*—the DVD release of *Dr. Atomic* won the 2012 Grammy for Best Opera Recording. Duluth audiences were enchanted by Ms. Cooke when she presented a concert for our 2011 season.

Called "one of the best chamber trios touring today," the **Morgenstern Trio** (violin, piano, violoncello) is based in Essen, Germany. The trio has been nominated for the European Concert Hall Organisation (ECHO) "Rising Stars" series.

The **Linden String Quartet** (two violins, viola, cello) recently completed a two-year residency at the Yale University School of Music, where the ensemble was mentored by the Tokyo String Quartet. Most recently, the quartet won the 2010 Concert Artists Guild Victor Elmaleh Competition and the ProQuartet Prize at the 9th Borciani International String Quartet Competition.

Pianist **Alexander Korsantia**, who began his musical training at an early age in Tbilisi, Georgia, has been praised for the "clarity of his technique, richly varied tone and dynamic phrasing." He won the First Prize and Gold Medal of the Artur Rubinstein Piano Master Competition and the First Prize at the Sidney International Piano Competition.

Free Shuttle Van

For concerts at Mitchell Auditorium, you can also catch the shuttle at the lower parking lot. The van will shuttle patrons from the lower parking lot up to Mitchell Auditorium until everyone is at the concert. The shuttle will return patrons to the parking lot or to these senior housing locations after the artists' reception following the performance. For concerts at Weber Music Hall, the van will also shuttle patrons from Parking Lot G at UMD (off St. Marie Street) to Ordean Court.
